### Biography

Raphaël Jardin was regional finalist of the Concours Voix Nouvelles 2018 in Tours, laureate of the International Competition of Interpretation of the French Melody in Toulouse and laureate of the International Competition of

the Masters of the French Chant in Paris in 2017.

Raphaël performed in April and May on the stage of the Opéra de Tours the role of Snout in Benjamin Britten's *A Midsummer Night's Dream* and the role of Almeric in *Iolanta* by Piotr Ilyich Tchaikovsky.

In June, Raphaël was heard as tenor soloist in Ludwig von Beethoven's *Fantaisie Chorale* under the baton of Benjamin Pionnier at the Grand Théâtre de Tours and in July with the Berlin Opera Academy in the role of Gabriel von Einsenstein in Johann Strauss's *Die Fledermaus* under the direction of Peter Leonard in a staging by Steven Anthony Whiting.

In April and May 2019, Raphaël Jardin will be on stage at the Opéra de Tours in the role of the Brother in *Die Sieben Todsünden* by Kurt Weill, directed by Pierre Bleuse in a staging by Olivier Desbordes and in the role of The Incredible in *Andréa Chénier* by Umberto Giordano under the direction of Benjamin Pionnier in a staging by Pier Francesco Maestrini alongside Béatrice Uria Monzon.

Among his future projects, Raphaël Jardin is Fritz (*La Nonne Sanglante*) at Opéra de Saint-Etienne.
